## 2<sup>ND</sup> MEIER Symposium

## on the Conservation of Endangered Tortoises

**REGISTRATION:** Please register yourself at the registration desk in front of the lecture room. You need your name badge to get free entrance to the zoo the following days. The registration desk will be open on Friday from 16.00 – 18.00h and on Saturday morning before the first talk. For registration afterwards please ask Christian and/or Philipp for help.

**PARKING:** Parking places at the zoo are available for 4 EUR per day. You have to pay in coins when you leave the parking place.

**PUBLIC TRANSPORT:** Allwetterzoo is part of the public transport in Münster. From Münster Main Station the bus line 14 ends at Allwetterzoo. Moreover, there is a regular connection between Münster City and Allwetterzoo via the boat Solaris.

**EVENT:** There will be a small event on Friday evening. It would be good if you have some cash with you – just in case.

**SYMPOSIUM FEE:** The symposium is for free but does not include the icebreaker and the social evening. Those events, including coffee breaks and lunch, have to be paid by everybody on its own.

**LECTURE ROOM:** Talks will be at the zoo school of the Allwetterzoo. You can find the zoo school between the main entrance building and the aquarium.

**BOOK STORE AND ART EXHIBIT:** CHIMAIRA publisher will be present in front of the lecture room. Moreover, there will be a small Turtle Art Exhibit by SIMON ROUOT at the same place.

**ICEBREAKER & Social Evening:** Both, the icebreaker and the social evening are located at the Greek restaurant Irodion, Mecklenbecker Str. 345, 48163 Münster. Parking at the restaurant is limited, but there are some few places further down the road.

**COFFEE BREAK AND LUNCH:** For coffee, lunch, etc. you can visit the Allwetterzoo restaurant located close to the lecture room. Please have in mind that the restaurant is open for zoo visitors too, so that you probably have to wait some time to get your drinks.

**GUIDED TOUR:** If you want to visit the IZS – International Center for Conservation of Turtles – there will be a guided tour at Sunday morning. Meeting point is the zoo entrance area.

**TOURS SUNDAY:** If you don't want to visit the IZS, but don't want to drive home directly, you can visit some nice places in the surroundings of Münster. The *Rieselfelder* are the hotspot for birdwatching in Germany and Telgte, a small town nearby, invites you to its historic center city.


